Beginning Activity (whole group)

Students meet Cam the Chameleon and learn that he has a problem. He doesn't know his colours and therefore is unable to camouflage. He needs the students' help!

Station 1: Mixing Colour

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

- Mix primary colours to create secondary colours using an assortment of hands on materials

Station 2: Transparent or Opaque

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

- Explore materials to determine if they are transparent or opaque using given materials and exploring materials around the room.

Station 3: Shades of Colour

Presenter runs this station

- Create a beautiful painting while exploring tints

Station 4: Natural and Manufactured

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

- Understanding that colours occur naturally and that they can be manufactured.
- Painting with an unexpected natural paint.



Station 5: Colours of the Rainbow

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

- Explore the colours of the rainbow through a variety of items
- Catch a rainbow!

Closing activity:

Students will teach Cam the Chameleon what they have learned about colours so that he can change colours.
