Activities

Whole group:

- Introduction to Canada's multi-cultural heritage.
- Meet some of the immigrant groups that helped form our country.
- Discuss cultural mosaics.

Stations

Various posters and props are part of this presentation to enrich the students' learning experience.

Station 1: Welcome to Canada!

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

- Postcard writing to people moving to Canada. Answering questions and discerning *what is Canadian/Albertan?*



Station 2: Puzzle of Me

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

- Learning about symbolism from around the world.
- Using symbols to create a personal puzzle.



Station 3: Settlers: Interview and Tableaus

Presenter runs this station

- Learning about immigrants to Canada and completing a news-style interview.

Station 4: Celebrations and Traditions

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

- Learning about traditions from other countries that help us understand why we do things.
- Planning a celebration activity.

Closing activity:

- Students present the interviews they have constructed.
