### Activities



#### Whole group:

The presenter greets the students and introduces the in-class fieldtrip...**an exploration of India!!** Students will learn the importance of **singing bowls** and plot India on a world map before embarking on an in depth look at Indian imports, exports, culture, festivals and daily life.

#### Station 1: Life in India

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

Students play a **custom board game** designed to test their knowledge of daily life in India.

#### Station 2: Culture and Artifacts

Presenter runs this station

Have a look at a typical classroom in India. How is it different from our own classrooms? Students learn about culture through examining **authentic Indian items**.



#### Station 3: Goods and Services

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

Have a close look at the imports, exports and goods & services of India. Students will sort picture cards into categories and **play a game exchanging rupees** for goods and services.

#### Station 4: Elephant Festival

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

Learn about traditional Elephant festivals and **decorate a handmade wooden elephant from India** to take home.

#### Closing activity:

All travelers return from their trip to India to share new knowledge and favourite experiences.
