## Activities:

### Whole group: Become an eXtreme eXplorer!

- Basic geography questions.
- **Speaking Inuktitut** with Tundra the Ookpik
- Pack up your dog sled and put on your parka! Mush!



### Station 1: Daily Life

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★☆☆

- How many Inuit can sleep in one igloo?
  - Learn about **food, transportation, and Inuit elders.**
  - Think you'd make a good hunter? Try our **animal tracking game!**
- Listen to an **Inuit legend** and **observe an authentic Inuit soapstone carving**

### Station 2: The Shaman

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★☆☆

- Who was the **Shaman**? What did he do?
- **Explore the items in the Shaman's pouch** (What do you think these items were used for?)
- **Using the rocks provided and teamwork, attempt to build an Inuksuk**



### Station 3: Caribou Hunting

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★☆☆

- Learn about the **importance of caribou hunting.**
- **Try writing in Inuktitut!**
- **Predict what the mystery item is and what it could be used for.**

### Station 4: The Inuksuk

Presenter runs this station

- **What's an Inuksuk** and what does it do?
- **Carve your own soapstone Inuksuk to take home!**



### Closing activity:

- Unpack your dogsled and relax after your journey
- Find out the answer to our **mystery item riddle.**
- Review questions about what was learned at each tour station and a final lesson in Inuktitut.
