Activities

Whole group:

- Students meet a member of the L.D.T. (Life cycle Discovery Team). **Students get to become a part of the team so they can help protect the animals on our planet Earth.** The best way to protect something is to learn as much as you can about it.
- Students participate in a fun **Classifying activity.**

Station 1: Butterfly Life Cycle

Presenter runs this station

- Students will explore the **magical change that a caterpillar goes through to become a butterfly.** In the end, students will have a lovely work of art.



Station 2: Frog Life Cycle

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

- Students will **explore the changes a frog goes through to become an adult frog** using magnetic shapes.

Station 3: Many Marvellous Mouths

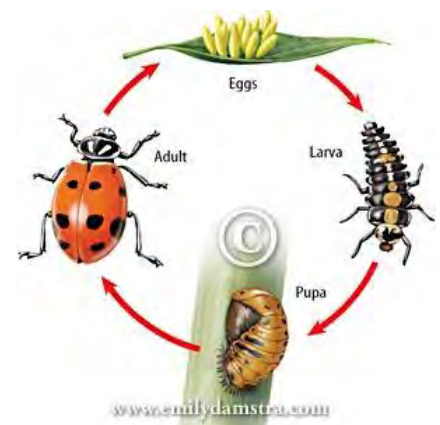
Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

- Different **animals eat different things and they all have special mouths** that help them eat the food they need. Students will **match the different types of mouths to the correct animal.**

Station 4: Loving Life Cycles

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

- Every animal goes through a life cycle but they don't all go through the same changes. Students will **look at different animals and predict the order of their life cycle.**



Station 5: Animals' Needs

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

- Students **investigate the different needs of animals and what a habitat is.**

Closing activity:

- The newest members of L.D.T. reflect on what they have learned throughout their adventure. Students will also discuss the **water cycle and acid rain.** L.D.T. members will make a **plan of challenges** they can do at home to better protect our Earth for all animals.
