



## Number Farm- Program Highlights

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: In this field trip, the parent volunteers are helpers to a small group of students. All levels of English Language Proficiency work for this field trip.

### Activities

#### Whole group:

- Mrs. MacDonald is here to tell you about the **big mess on old MacDonald's Farm**. She left the gate open and the pigs, cows, chickens and sheep got into the barn and into the paint. Students will **practice their sorting skills** by sorting these mixed up animals by colour, size and type.



#### Activity One:

- Students learn about what 3D is as they **build and colour their own 3D animal** to take home.

#### Activity Two:

- Students head to their tables to complete the first part of the Old MacDonald poster. **Students put the right number of animal cut outs in each pen, field or meadow.** They **count corn stalks, tractors and ducks and practice their number printing** on their poster as well.



#### Activity Three:

- Students learn about **patterns including what they are, how we can make one and how we can continue one.** Students then work to complete the last part of the Old Macdonald poster by **making a pattern with various coloured flowers.**

#### Closing activity:

- Students gather for an interesting story version of "Old Macdonald Had a Farm" and to sing the classic version of the song.
