

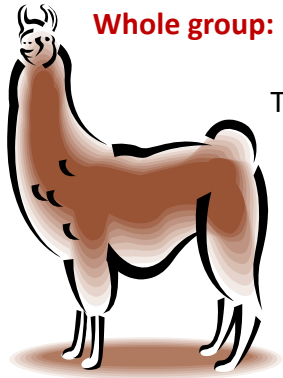

Activities



Whole group:

The presenter greets the students and invites them on **an exploration of Peru!** Students learn the importance of **gourds** in Peruvian culture and **plot Peru on a world map** before embarking on an in-depth look at Peruvian imports, exports, culture, festivals and daily life.

A Look into Peru

Station 1: Life in Peru

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

Students play a **custom board game** designed to test their knowledge of daily life in Peru.

Station 2: School and Culture

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

Students have a look at a typical classroom in Peru. How is it different from our own classrooms? Students **learn about and play a traditional Peruvian game.**

Station 3: Goods and Services

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

Students have a close look at the imports, exports and goods & services of Peru. Students play an Import/Export game before **exchanging Nuevo Sol** for goods and services.

Station 4: Artifacts

Presenter runs this station

Students learn more about the tradition of **gourd carving**. Examine 20 different **authentic Peruvian items** directly from Peru. Each student receives their own **worry doll pin** to wear and take home.

Closing activity:

All travelers return from their trip to Peru to share new knowledge and favourite experiences.
