## Activities

### Whole group:

Scuba Charlotte takes the students on an **ocean adventure** where they will discover many wonderful things about their **5 Senses**. Students put on their **imaginary scuba gear** and swim down to a **coral reef** for an exciting ocean themed adventure.



### Station 1: Touch

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

- Students will use their **sense of touch** to explore different objects.
- They will discover some words we can use to describe touch.
- Students will **feel around in a pail of sand and water** to hunt for some mystery objects.



### Station 2: Smell & Taste

Presenter runs this station

- Students will discover **how some ocean animals use their sense of smell and taste**.
- Students will **try to identify some mystery smells and taste**.

### Station 3: Sight

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

- Students will **build an optical illusion craft** and **discover how our sense of sight can sometimes trick us**.

### Station 4: Hearing

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

- Students will **try to identify some ocean sounds** and they will play a game using just their ears to guide them. Students will also **discover some ways to protect our senses**.

### Station 5: Sea Lions

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

- Students will **discover which senses help sea lions find their babies, which senses sea lions use to find food and what senses they rely on to tell them that danger is near**.



### Closing activity:

- Students gather in the story corner to take off their imaginary scuba gear and to tell Scuba Charlotte what they've learned about their 5 senses.
