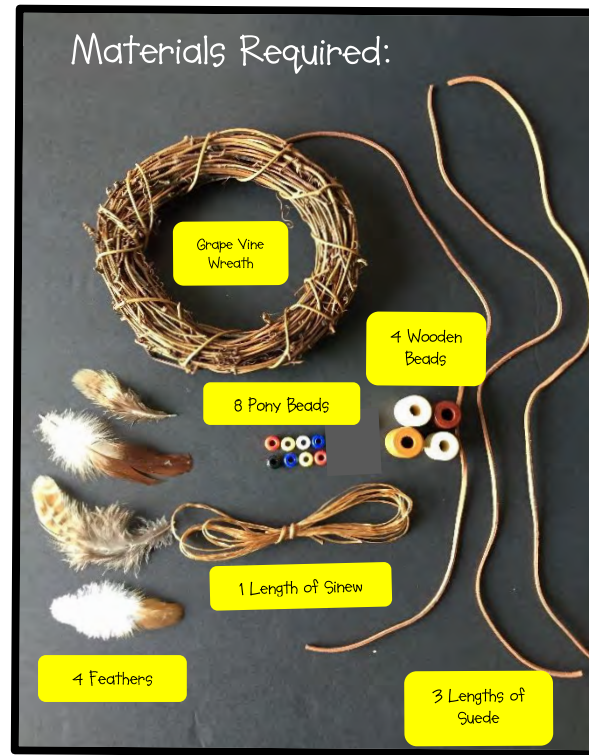




# Dreamcatchers



## Step-by-Step Instructions

Choose the simple or complex weaving process for your dreamcatcher.  
 Note: Step 2 is the only step of the process that is different between the two types of dreamcatchers.

### Step 2: Simple Weave



Wrap the sinew around the outer edge of the wreath. Go in different directions to create a star-like pattern.



Then, tie the end of the sinew around the wreath and ensure it is secure.

### Step 2: Complex Weave

Wrap the sinew loosely around the wreath away from you.



Then, bring the sinew back through the loop you just made.

Move 1-2 inches over and repeat this process until you complete one full round around the wreath.



Continue this weaving process through the sinew loops on the inside layer. Tie off the end when you reach the centre. Cut off excess sinew. Note: As you weave, you can add 1-2 pony beads in the centre of the dreamcatcher if you wish.



Step 1: Using one end of the sinew, tie a knot at the top of the wreath. Double knot it so it does not come undone.



Step 3: Take one length of suede and tie a knot where the two ends meet.



Step 4: Create a slipknot at the top of your wreath. This will be for hanging your dreamcatcher.



Step 5: At the bottom of your wreath, create a slipknot using another length of suede.



Step 6: Repeat Step 5 using the third piece of suede.



Step 7: Lay your wreath down on the table and thread two pony beads of your choice through each piece of suede.



Step 8: Add one wooden bead to the end of each piece of suede.

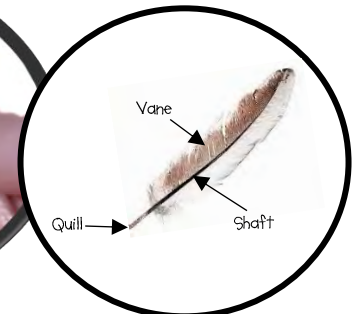
Note: If you added pony beads in the centre of your dreamcatcher for the complex weave, you will have to adjust your beads accordingly.



Step 9: Prepare to tie a knot at the end of one piece of suede, but do NOT tighten the knot all the way.



Step 10: Feed the quill of a feather into the knot and then tighten.



Optional: Cut off excess suede and/or place a tiny drop of super glue to seal the end to ensure the knot does not come undone (glue not included).

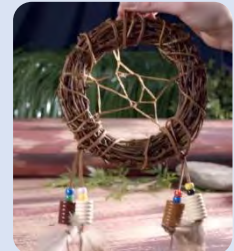


Step 11: Repeat Step 9 and 10 with the remaining feathers.
