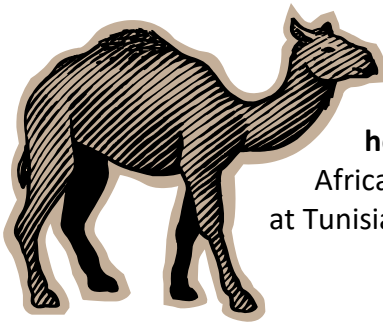

Activities



Whole group:

The students will be embarking on **an exploration of Tunisia!** Students will **hear a story about galimotos** and examine one of these interesting and unique African toys. They **plot Tunisia on a world map** before embarking on an in depth look at Tunisian imports, exports, culture, festivals and daily life.

A Look into Tunisia

Station 1: Life in Tunisia

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

Students play a **custom board game** designed to test their knowledge of daily life in Tunisia.

Station 2: School and Culture

Presenter runs this station

Students will look at a typical classroom in Tunisia. How is it different from our own classrooms? Students **learn about and play traditional Tunisian games**. They also examine many **authentic Tunisian artifacts** that have been sourced straight from Tunisia.



Station 3: Goods and Services

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

Students have a close look at the imports, exports and goods & services of Tunisia. Students sort import and export cards before **exchanging dinars** for goods and services.

Station 4: Mosaics

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

Students learn more about Tunisian mosaics and the history of this Tunisian art form. Students work on their own **mosaic design**.

Closing activity:

All travelers return from their trip to Tunisia to share new knowledge and favourite experiences.
