Activities



Whole group:

The students will embark on an **exploration of Ukraine!** Students will **learn about the September 1st celebrations that happen in Ukraine** and hear the ringing of the first bell. They **plot Ukraine on a world map** before embarking on an in depth look at Ukrainian imports, exports, culture, festivals and daily life.

A Look into Ukraine

Station 1: Life in Ukraine

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★

Students play a **custom board game** designed to test their knowledge of daily life in Ukraine.

Station 2: School and Culture

Presenter runs this station

Students look at a typical classroom in Ukraine. How is it different from our own classrooms? Students **learn about and play a traditional Ukrainian game**. They also **examine many authentic Ukrainian artifacts** that have been sourced from Ukraine.



Station 3: Goods and Services

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★★★

Students have a close look at the imports, exports and goods & services of Ukraine. Students play a “What am I?” game before **exchanging Hryvnia** for goods and services.

Station 4: Clay Pottery

Volunteer English Language Proficiency: ★

Students learn more about Ukrainian pottery and the history of this Ukrainian art form. Students decorate their own piece of **pottery with a traditional design**.

Closing activity:

All travelers return from their trip to Ukraine to share new knowledge and favourite experiences.
